Winter Family Camp Packing List

We recommend comfortable, casual clothing which won't be damaged by camp activity. All items must be clearly labeled for identification. The Antiochian Village is not responsible for any lost, damaged, or stolen items.

- Nice outfit for Divine Liturgy
- Warm clothes – warm socks, winter hats, gloves, coats, etc.
- Long pants (jeans or sweats are ok) for services each day
- Sturdy tennis/athletic shoes/boots
- Sweater, sweatshirt, or lightweight jacket
- Waterproof rain coat or poncho
- Pillows, linens, sleeping bags or blankets (for those staying in cabins)
- Towels, washcloth, and personal toiletries, soap, shampoo (for those staying in cabins)
- Flashlight
- Alarm Clock
- Optional: camera, journal, water bottle

LEAVE HOME...

- ✘ Food
- ✘ Electronics, cell phones, electronic games, etc.
- ✘ Jewelry and other valuables, including sports equipment.
- ✘ All tobacco and alcohol products
- ✘ Immodest apparel
- ✘ Dangerous implements, i.e. knives, axes, fireworks, etc.
- ✘ Any illegal substances
- ✘ Pets
- ✘ Any aerosol products (hairspray, deodorant, insect repellent, etc)

Dress Code

While camping is of its nature informal, Christian modesty should be taken into account when packing for your family's stay. Inappropriate clothing (i.e. inappropriate messages, short shorts or skirts, revealing or skin-tight clothing) will not be permitted. For church services, shorts are not allowed, and a nice outfit should be worn for Divine Liturgy.
