

Frequently Asked Questions



Who is able to come to Adult Camp?

Adult Camp is for any adult age 21 and up. All are invited – whether single or married, clergy or laity, 21 or 101, whether you've been to camp before or not…if you're 21 and older, we want you to join us for a weekend of fun!

Will there be transportation to the airport or train station?

We will offer transportation to and from the Pittsburgh (PIT) and Latrobe (LBE) airports, as well as the Johnstown (JST) train station, for an additional fee of \$10 each way. Flights into Pittsburgh must arrive on Friday of Adult Camp before 6pm, and flights out of Pittsburgh must depart on Monday of Adult Camp after 12pm. Flights in and out of Latrobe and trains in and out of Johnstown can arrive and depart at any time due to the limited schedules and proximity to camp.

What is the cost of Adult Camp and what is included in the cost?

Adult Camp costs \$195 for the weekend, and includes all meals, lodging, programming, and Adult Camp t-shirt!

Where will I be staying?

Campers will be staying in one of our new cabins. Each cabin is heated and has a private bathroom with 2 sinks, a shower, and a toilet. Each has 4 sets of bunkbeds (8 beds total, 7 twinbeds and 1 full bed). Cabins are part of a double-cabin which are connected by a common room. Cabins are easily accessible to the main part of the camp.



What if I'm married? Can I room with my spouse?

All campers will be placed in cabins according to gender. If you are married and want to stay with your spouse, please contact our office and we can talk about potential options.

Can I request roommates?

Yes! When you register, there will be a place to request roommates. This is not something we can guarantee but we will do our best to accommodate requests!

What if I have children? Can I bring them too?

As much as we love having kids at camp – our Summer Camp, Winter Camp, and Family Camp programs are all excellent opportunities for children to attend camp. Adult Camp is only for adults ages 21+. If you have kids and want to come to Adult Camp, this is a great opportunity to let them stay with a relative or family friend for the weekend while you get a little time away!

What should I bring?

You will need to bring clothing, bedding, and toiletries. For clothing, we suggest you dress in layers as it can get cool in the mornings and evenings. It is wise to bring a sweatshirt or light jacket. For bedding, we suggest you bring a sheet and blanket and/or sleeping bag. Please do not bring any drugs, alcohol, weapons, or pets.

Are there rules at Adult Camp?

Yes, we have Expectations for the weekend. You will agree to these while registering, and they can be found on our website.

Is this the same as Alumni Weekend? Is it just for Village Alumni?

Absolutely not! Adult Camp is for all adults ages 21+, whether you've been to camp before or not!

Is this like a young adult retreat?

Nope! Adult camp is for all adults, whether they are 21 or 101. And it is not a retreat. We have done our best to provide a schedule and programming that is nearly identical to our Summer Camp program, while throwing in a few adult twists!
