# Family Camp Miscellaneous Info

When You Arrive, please park in the parking lot and come to the Welcome Lodge (office next to the parking lot) to register, pay any remaining balance, get your cabin assignment and packet of information. Then head to the Dining Hall to enjoy food and fellowship!

#### **Mealtime Announcements!**

We will make important announcements during each meal once everyone has been served. Communication is important and we'll do our best to be short and sweet. Please remain in the Dining Hall until you hear the announcements. On Saturday morning please make sure your child(ren) are in the Dining Hall by 9:45am so we can begin our program.

#### Childcare & Supervision of Children

Due to the large number of infants and toddlers, our staff will be running a nursery that will be open during designated times as noted on the schedule. The nursery will be for children ages 0-3 and will be very close to the adult sessions with the speaker(s) in the Conference Center. When you leave your child(ren) at the nursery, we will write down your phone number should our staff need to contact you as well as put a name tag on your child(ren).

While the parents are in their sessions with the speaker(s) (Saturday morning and Sunday afternoon) and also during the wine & cheese social (Sunday night), our staff will provide programming and take responsibility of supervising your children should you choose to leave them with us. *At all other times during Family Camp, parents are responsible for the supervision of their children*.

#### **Accommodations for Small Children**

We have about 8 highchairs and booster seats for meals, as well as two Pack-n-Plays that will be used in our nursery. If you are able, please feel free to bring your own play-pens, highchairs, etc.

#### **Cell Phones & Electronics**

Family Camp is a wonderful opportunity to get away from distractions and focus on our time together. Please use your cell phone and electronics as little as possible, and if you must make a phone call, we ask that you step away to do so.

#### **First Aid Kits**

#### **Emergency Procedures**

In case of an emergency please find a staff member immediately.

If it is the middle of the night and no staff members are around, please call one of the following numbers:

If emergency merits gathering of the entire camp, one of the following bells will ring:

- Fire Bell (3 rings, pause, 3 rings, pause and repeating). This would occur during fire or any emergency requiring gathering of entire camp when no hazards exist for doing so.
- Lock Down (2 rings, pause, 2 rings, pause, and repeating). This would be used if any dangerous individuals or animals were found on camp. All campers and staff should immediately proceed to closest indoor location, with doors locked if possible.

Take Shelter (4 rings, pause, 4 rings, pause, and repeating). This would be rung in case of tornado or other severe weather. All campers proceed to the closest basement (Old Dining Hall Basement, Dining Hall Basement, Cabins 1 & 2 Basement, Lodge Basement, Church Basement)
